**Hope Explored** Three-week course that explains the good news of Jesus Christ, starting **Tuesday 5th November** in the centre at **8pm**.

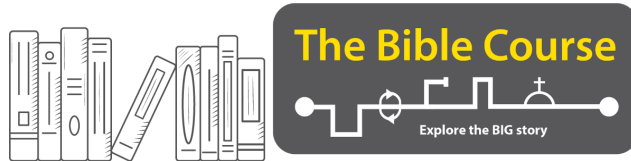

At Holy Trinity Wallington our vision is to be:

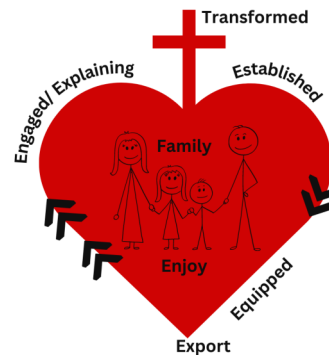
### ***A growing family where God transforms lives through Jesus***

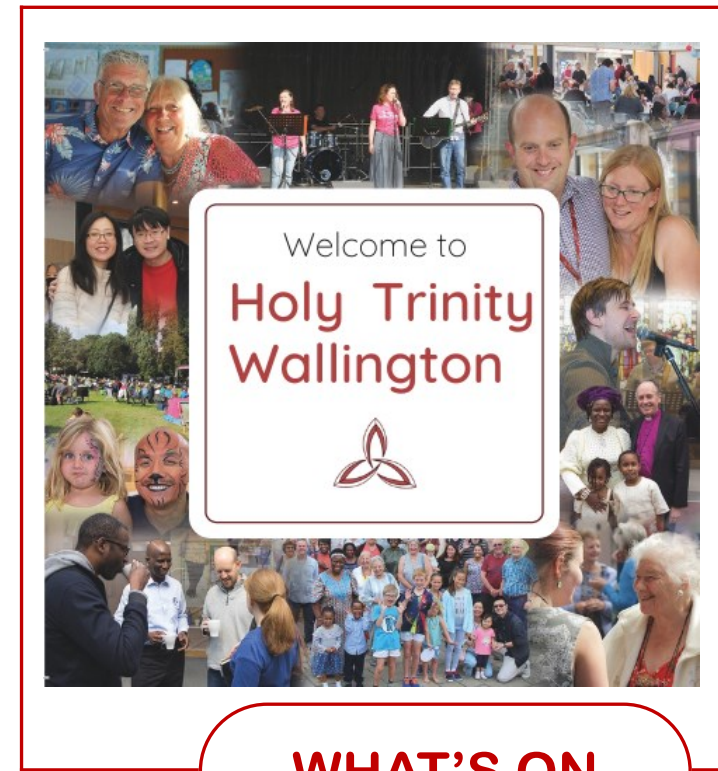
